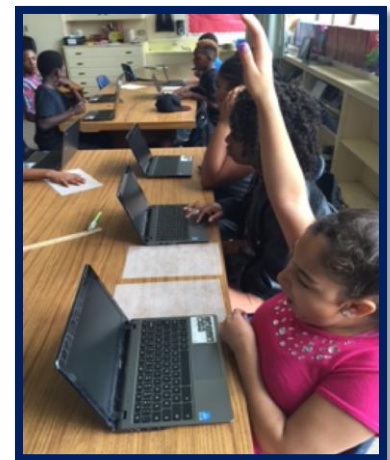
**We are proud to announce that School2Home will be expanded to all grades in the 2018-2019 school year!**

- During the 2015-16 school year, the program was implemented in the 5th and 6th grade, reaching 66 students in two classes.
- The program was highly successful, receiving positive remarks from students, teachers, school administrators, and parents.



### What is School2Home?

- School2Home is a digital literacy program funded by the California Emerging Technology Fund. With project support from Valley Vision, a local nonprofit, the program has been implemented at Leataata Floyd Elementary – the first elementary school to do so statewide.
- Learning to use technology use is at the center of this program, both in the classroom and for homework.
- We are very happy to report that every student has access to a school owned laptop for use in the classroom, with the potential to take the device home.
- In order for a student to be allowed to take their laptop home, their parent must complete a short digital training course which will be offered throughout the year at school events.
- Parents will be able to see what their children are working on at school, and can get access themselves to services.
- Parents will be able to see the technological skills their students are developing at student showcases and tech activities such as those with HackerLab.
